

Dear school principals, dear teachers and dear parents,

On January 27, 2024, our annual cultural competition will take place. On this day, our students have the opportunity to showcase their cultural skills and demonstrate what they have learned over the past year. Given the time and effort invested by the students, it is our responsibility to honor this by attentively observing their performances.

This year, to ensure the smooth running of the event and in light of damages incurred in previous years, we have implemented some measures and introduced rules.

1. The hall will be arranged without tables, resembling a theater setup, as it is a school examination/competition.
2. Food and beverages are prohibited in the hall. Refreshments are available in the foyer and only during breaks.
3. Seats in the front rows are reserved for students and teachers according to the registration form. This means that all students of a section will be seated together.
4. On the event day, there will be a briefing for all teachers and assistant supervisors at 8:30 am.
5. Teachers act as supervisors and are responsible for ensuring that their students remain quiet and attentive during performances of other sections, and that they are ready for their own performances on time. Students must inform supervisors when leaving their seats.
6. A student is appointed as an assistant supervisor for each section to support teachers. Please provide (school principals) us with the names of the assistant supervisors by no later than January 10, 2024.
7. Reserved changing rooms are labeled and available.
8. Supervisors and assistant supervisors are responsible for ensuring that their students receive lunch and snacks, and that they respect others' property during breaks.
9. Sufficient parking is available and free of charge. Although the venue is centrally located and within walking distance from the train station, we still recommend using public transportation.
10. We look forward to experiencing this special day together with parents. To make the most of the on-site offerings, we kindly request not to bring outside food; instead, in addition to the lunch included in the ticket, various delicious options (La-Phing, Corn-dog, Shabale, Momo und Idly-Bonda) will be available for purchase.  
Admission, food and item (buddhist stuffs, tibetan dresses etc.) sales are cash only.

It's important to note that we have designed the program to include sufficient breaks, and the event will conclude no later than 7:00 pm.

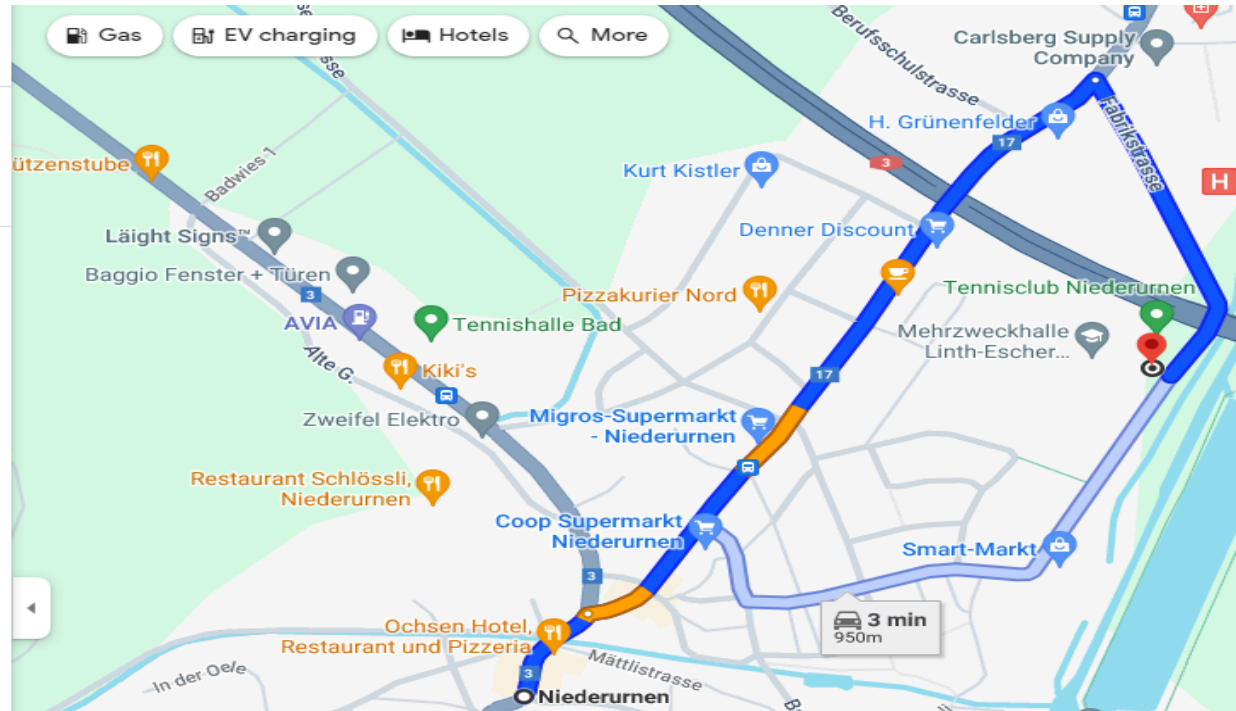
